The defendant, Jose Mora, moves this Court, pursuant to Rule 7.4(b), Ariz.R.Crim.P., to review the conditions of his release and release him on his own recognizance, or into the third-party custody of Pretrial Services, or impose the least onerous condition of release which assures the court of his appearance.

At the time of the initial appearance on April 17, 2025 and February 17, 2025, bond was set in the amount of \$250,000 and \$50,000 respectively. The defendant is not financially able to post bond and has therefore remained in custody since that time. Both cases have since been indicted and transferred from Pima County Justice Court to the Superior Court of

Pima County, which is a qualifying change in circumstances to justify a hearing on this motion.

The factors to be considered in determining the method of release in criminal cases in Arizona are set forth in A.R.S. §13-3967. The defendant meets several of the release criteria enumerated in the above-mentioned statute. The factors that should be considered are:

1. Mr. Mora has lived in Tucson for 28 years.
2. Mr. Mora has no criminal record of any time in those years. Likewise, he has no history of failure to appear and no known connections outside of the State of Arizona, weighing against him being a flight risk.
3. Mr. Mora was previously employed as a handyman with his family. His family has continued that work and he will be employed should he be able to post a reasonable bond.
4. Mr. Mora can live with his wife, Rosa Mora, who has indicated that she will take third party custody of Mr. Mora.
5. The allegations in these cases are old, there have been no recent allegations against Mr. Mora, indicating that he would not be a danger to the community if released on bond or by the court to pretrial services.

The policy of the courts and legislature is announced by Rule 7.2, Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure. This rule announces a rebuttable presumption that a defendant be released on his own recognizance. In order to rebut this presumption for release on recognizance, the court must make a determination that such release will not be sufficient to

ensure the defendant's future appearance. Unless this affirmative duty to make a finding is complied with, release is mandated by the rule.

In the event that the court makes the preliminary determination called for by Rule 7.2, yet a second level of analysis, in setting the terms of release, is called for. The court must determine the least onerous condition "which will reasonably assure his appearance." A non-inclusive listing of possible conditions is incorporated into Rule 7.3. Only one of the six options listed in Rule 7.3(b) is concerned with money bail. The others describe possibilities available to the court which permit the defendant to be at liberty, or partial liberty, until the time of trial.

The concept of Rule 7, Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure, is in keeping with the concepts embodied by the Eighth Amendment to the United States Constitution and Article II, §15 of the Arizona Constitution prohibiting excessive bail. Elaboration of alternatives in the rule is an effort to articulate the several choices available to the court in determining the mode of defendant's release. Emphasis is placed on alternatives other than money bail because such alternatives are in keeping with the structures of the Arizona and United States Constitutions, and the presumption of innocence upon which our system of criminal justice is based. In addition, non-monetary release conditions operate in a non-discriminatory way on indigent defendants who may not even have the financial resources to make what may appear to be a low bond in absolute terms. See *Stack v. Boyle*, 342 U.S. 1, 96 L.Ed. 3 (1951). This is precisely the situation in this case. Thus, although the bail amount set would be manageable to a person of means, it is beyond hope to one without funds. It is appropriate based on the specific facts of the present case and the applicable law discussed herein to

release him on conditions reasonably ensuring his appearance, but without the requisite of money bail.

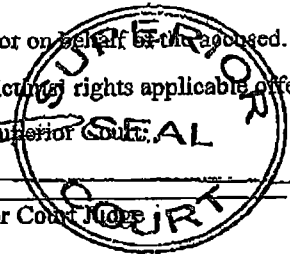




